1. Madhya Bhotekoshi Jalavidyut Company Limited (MBJCL), the Employer, is a Company promoted by Chilime Hydropower Company Limited (CHPCL). MBJCL has completed the financial closure including the debt portion required for the Project with Employees Provident Fund (EPF) and equity investment will be made from CHPCL, Nepal Electricity Authority (NEA), Local Promoters and the general public. It is intended that the part of the proceeds of these resources will be applied to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Bid Document has been issued.
2. The Employer invites sealed Bids from the prequalified eligible Bidders who are interested in undertaking the manufacture and installation of the Lot 2- Electromechanical Works of the Middle Bhotekoshi Hydroelectric Project (MBKHEP), with a capacity of 102 MW located in Sindhupalchowk District of Bagmati zone in the Central Development Region of Nepal.
3. The works are based on FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Plant and Design-Build – First Edition, 1999. The Electromechanical Works include Design, Manufacture, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Electromechanical Equipment.
4. This Invitation for Bids has been addressed to the following prequalified Bidders:

5. Interested prequalified Bidders may obtain further information from the office of the Employer (address provided below) during office hours. A complete set of Bid Documents in English may be obtained free of cost from **22nd September 2013 to 21st November 2013**, during office hours on submission of written application to the address given below.
6. Pre-Bid meeting will be held at **14:00 hrs. on 27th October 2013** at the address provided below. All Bidders who intend to submit Bids are strongly advised to attend.
7. Bidding process will be conducted under a competitive Bidding method using the procedures as described in the Bidding Documents.
8. Bid documents along with one set of original and two sets of duplicates signed by authorized personnel, must be submitted in wax sealed envelopes and delivered to the address of Employer's office stated below under number 14 at **12:00 hrs. on or before 22nd November 2013**. Documents received after this deadline will not be accepted.
9. Bids shall be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at **14:00 hrs. on 22nd November 2013** at the address of Employer's Office stated below under number 14. Bids must be valid for a period of 180 days counting from the last date of Bid submission and must be accompanied by **Bid Security, amounting to NRs 85,000,000.00 (Nepalese Rupees Eighty Five Million only) or equivalent US\$ 835,000.00 (US Dollar Eight Hundred Thirty Five Thousand only)**. The Bid Security shall be valid for minimum 60 days beyond the Bid validity period.
10. If the last date of purchasing, submission and opening falls on a company holiday, then the next working day shall be considered the last day.
11. It is recommended that eligible Bidders familiarize themselves with the local conditions and visit the project site to obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract. Cost incurred for preparation of Bidding Documents and the site visit will be solely at the expense of the Bidder and the Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for the costs associated with it.
12. The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject, wholly or partly any or all the Bids without assigning reason, whatsoever.
